Each piece of artwork can be no larger than 28" x 28" x 4" (28 inches
high, 28 inches wide, and 4 inches deep), including the frame. If
your artwork is selected as the winning piece, it will be required to be
framed and must still adhere to the size guidelines. Three dimen-
sional artwork is not eligible, and non glass framing.
